

Terms & Conditions - Event Organiser Course

1. Conditions of Entry

By completing the designated course entry process candidates are agreeing to abide by the following terms and conditions. It is the candidate's responsibility to provide accurate and truthful information when completing the entry process, any errors in data entered is the responsibility of the candidate.

2. Payment

Each candidate is required to pay the entry fee in full, along with any administration fees which may apply at the time of entry. Once payment is received and entry is confirmed, the fee is non-refundable other than as set out in section 4 below. Administration fees are non-refundable in all circumstances.

3. Confirmation of entry

Entry to the course is confirmed by Entry Central via email to the email address provided by the candidate only upon completion of the entry process.

4. Candidate's withdrawal policy & refunds

If the candidate wishes to withdraw from the course they must do so by informing Triathlon Scotland in writing by email to events@triathlonscotland.org. Full refunds will be issued to the candidate up to 14 days before the Event. No refunds will be issued less than 14 days before the event.

5. Transfer & swapping of entries

Candidates can transfer or swap their entry to another person only with permission from the Triathlon Scotland.

6. Photography

Triathlon Scotland has the right to use images, photographs and video taken by their contracted photographers and employees at the course without informing the candidate. These images will only be used for the purposes of promoting, reporting and broadcasting the event, and any other promotion related to the business activities of Triathlon Scotland. Any individual who does not wish to have their image used for these purposes must inform Triathlon Scotland on course entry by emailing events@triathlonscotland.org. Notification after the course can be made and Triathlon Scotland will use its best endeavours to prevent images of that candidate being used but cannot guarantee it.

7. Medical Conditions & Information

All candidates are required to provide emergency contact details as part of the entry process, and to disclose any known medical conditions to Triathlon Scotland. If you know or are concerned that you have a medical condition which might interfere with your safe participation in the course, before you enter you should seek advice from a relevant medical professional and follow that advice.

7. Collection & use of data

The candidate agrees and consents to Triathlon Scotland using his/her personal details provided in his/her Online Registration Form or otherwise and for the following purposes:

Event administration

(a) Triathlon Scotland requires a record of each candidate's registration details including third party emergency contact details for internal administration purposes in order to properly conduct and to safely administer the course.

(b) The Participant agrees to receive emails from Triathlon Scotland containing course information before and after the event.

(c) Triathlon Scotland will also keep records of medical information provided that it is kept confidential and may be shared only with medical personnel or teams allocated to the course. Such information shall be deleted within a reasonable time following the completion of the course.

E-mail communications

(a) Triathlon Scotland will use the candidate's contact data submitted on the Online Registration Form or otherwise to send the candidate information by e-mail relating to the course, other courses and any further categories of news and promotional information as the candidate may have requested on the Online Registration Form.

(b) The candidate acknowledges and agrees that the Organiser may send an e-mail notification following the course inviting the candidate to provide feedback on the course.

All candidate data will be managed and stored securely by Triathlon Scotland in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998 and the General Data Protection Regulation 2018.
